And

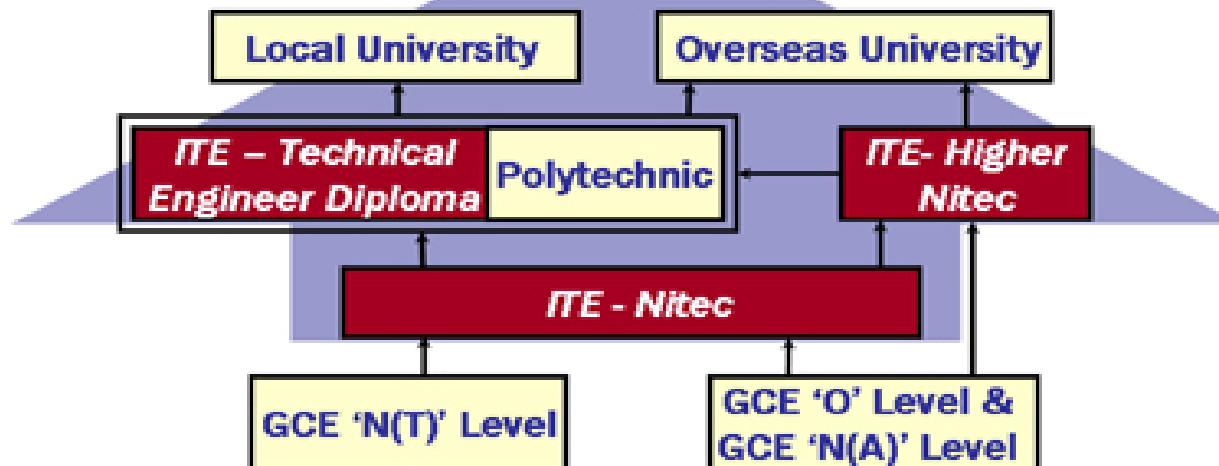
One other subject: Grade B or better

- the basic knowledge, skills and values relevant for the new developments in the **services sector**



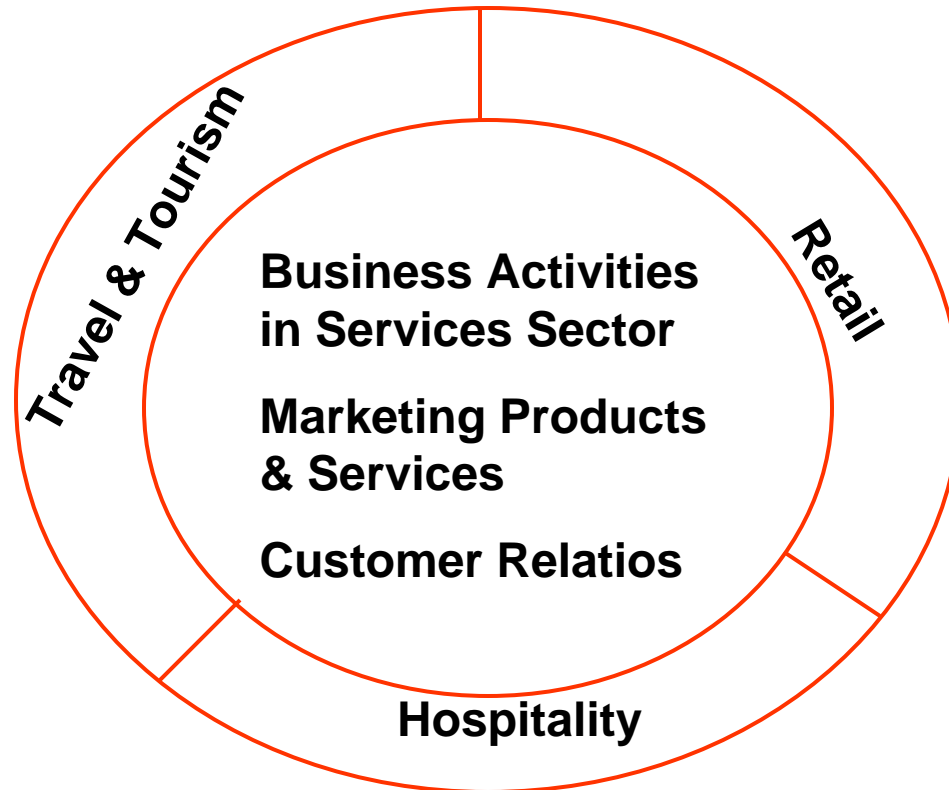
EBS – Focus

Paper	Duration	Weighting
Paper 1 (Written Paper)	1½ hours	60%
Paper 2 (Coursework: School-based Assessment)	20 hours (supervised work)	40%
