Criteria

1. The **Caring Teacher** demonstrates the core values (**G-Gracious; D-Determined; L- Loyal; and S- Sincere**) of the school in fostering a conducive environment for student well-being and actively seeks to provide a culture of care, trust and friendliness that enhances the well being and character of the students.
2. The **Innovative Teacher (Pedagogy)** is the teacher who has a 'can-do' attitude, dares to be different and takes risks, is adaptable to changes, seeking improvements and uses creative and innovative methods that have made a real impact on student learning.
3. The **Inspiring Teacher** is the teacher who excites, influences and enthuses students to do well through words and deeds. He/She is able to guide students to become **thinking and gracious youths, with distinguished service and leadership. He exemplifies the school motto: serve, lead and excel.**
4. The **ICT Teacher** is the ICT-savvy teacher who has impacted teaching and learning positively with the use of technology.
5. The **Skillful Teacher** is an excellent classroom teacher who delivers engaging and stimulating lessons with good student results/outcomes, caters for the social, emotional development of the students and demonstrates excellent classroom management. He/She is able to establish good rapport with parents too.
6. The **Nurturing Teacher** is the teacher who demonstrates the passion and commitment to nurture the whole student, sees the possibilities in each student, acts consistently in the interest of the student and persists in working for the best possible outcomes to realize the student's full potential.
7. The **Service Excellence Award** is for the officer who has showed personal qualities that reflect **Courtesy, Accessibility, Responsiveness and Effectiveness (CARE)** in service excellence. He/She has exceeded customer expectations or internal service standards.

Eligibility

Nominees for the awards should be **Full Time or Part Time staff**, have at least 1 year of teaching/working experience in and demonstrate the stated criteria in their dealings with their colleagues and/or students.
