Maximum points 6 pts**

4) PARTICIPATION

Attendance at least 75% in main CCA

Sports Day, SYF Opening Ceremony,
National Day Parade

***Highest points for 3 activities will be totaled up**

***Maximum points 10 points**

Total number of CIP hours over 4 or 5 years
Including required 7 CIP hours per year

***100 or more hours 5pts**

***80-99 hours 4pts**

***60-79 hours 3pts**

***40-59 hours 2 pts**

***24-39 hours 1 pt**
